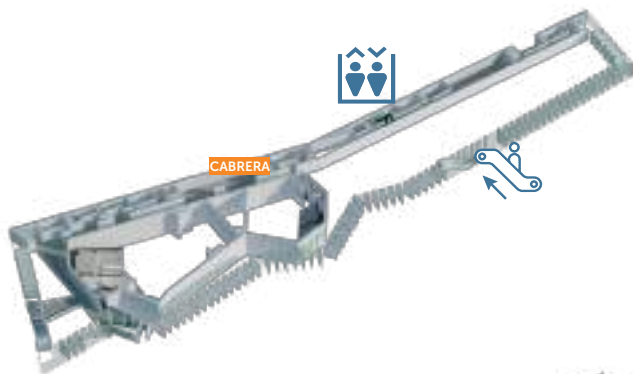


VENUE MAP
